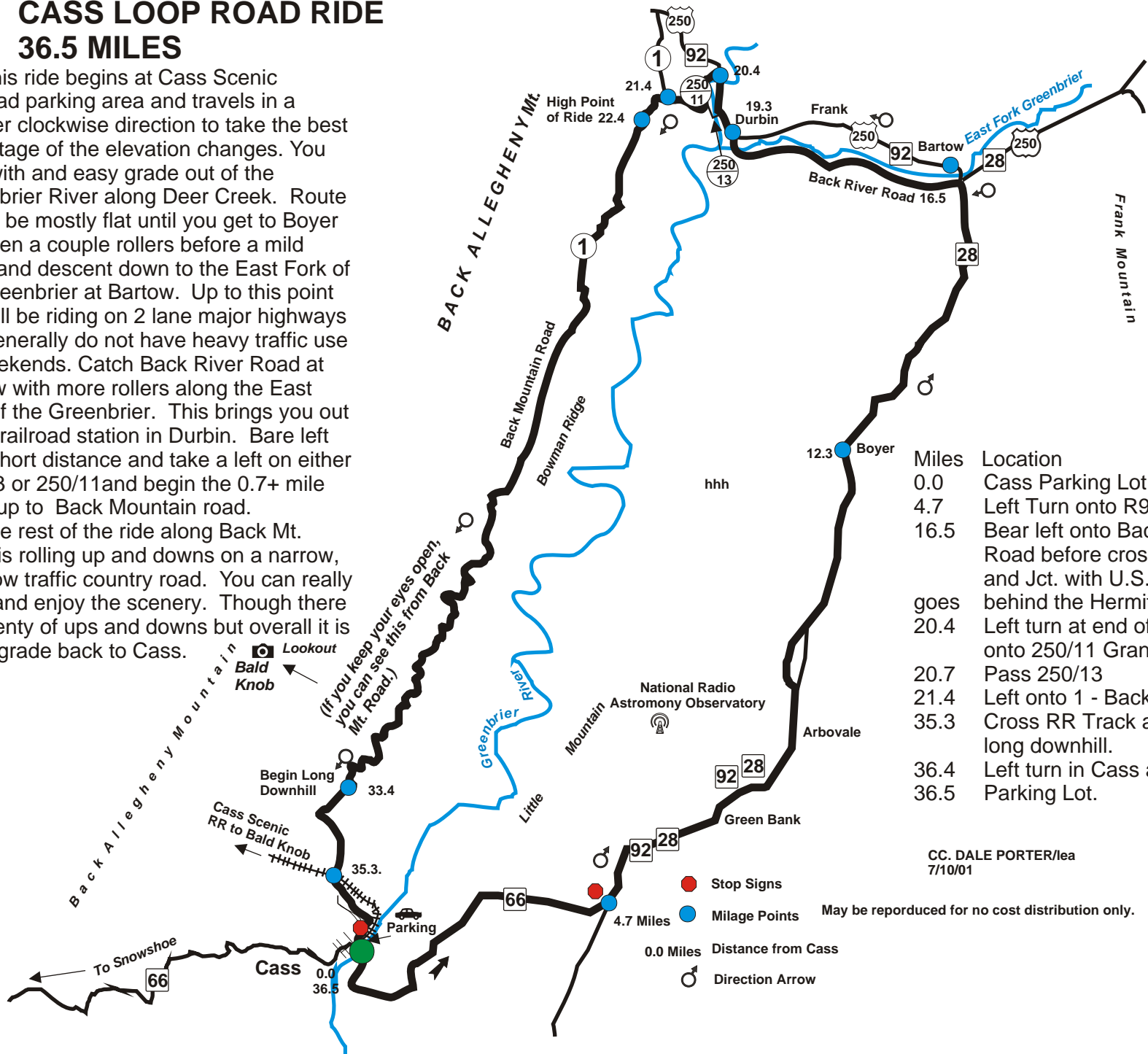


CASS LOOP ROAD RIDE

36.5 MILES

This ride begins at Cass Scenic Railroad parking area and travels in a counter clockwise direction to take the best advantage of the elevation changes. You start with an easy grade out of the Greenbrier River along Deer Creek. Route 92 will be mostly flat until you get to Boyer and then a couple rollers before a mild climb and descent down to the East Fork of the Greenbrier at Bartow. Up to this point you will be riding on 2 lane major highways that generally do not have heavy traffic use on weekends. Catch Back River Road at Bartow with more rollers along the East Fork of the Greenbrier. This brings you out at the railroad station in Durbin. Bear left for a short distance and take a left on either 250/13 or 250/11 and begin the 0.7+ mile climb up to Back Mountain road.

The rest of the ride along Back Mt. Road is rolling up and downs on a narrow, very low traffic country road. You can really relax and enjoy the scenery. Though there are plenty of ups and downs but overall it is down grade back to Cass.



Miles	Location
0.0	Cass Parking Lot
4.7	Left Turn onto R92
16.5	Bear left onto Back River Road before crossing bridge and Jct. with U.S. 250. (It goes behind the Hermitage Motel.)
20.4	Left turn at end of bridge onto 250/11 Grant Road
20.7	Pass 250/13
21.4	Left onto 1 - Back Mt. Road
35.3	Cross RR Track at end of long downhill.
36.4	Left turn in Cass at stop.
36.5	Parking Lot.
